Since 2010 I have worked with many public bodies and publishers, often turning complex scientific and historical information, or difficult social issues into accessible visual narratives. Recent clients include, Nobrow Press, Bloomsbury, Scribner, Public Health England, Arts Council England, The Wellcome Trust, The National Trust, Positive Negatives and the Heritage Lottery Fund. I am the author and illustrator of the Wellcome Trust funded graphic novel, 'Out of Nothing', which won the 2018 Cheltenham Illustration Award. My second graphic novel 'Two Heads', with Uta, Chris and Alex Frith was published internationally in 2022.

Alongside personal projects I often undertake commissions that are socially engaged, working and collaborating with different communities in order to generate artworks or convey hidden narratives. For example I was commissioned to produce a 17m public artwork for the Royal Sussex County Hospital's new building. Working with medics, staff, patients, local historians and a wide range of community groups, I collected histories and personal experiences, all of which I used as content and inspiration. In 2018 the Martin Fisher Foundation commissioned me to design the messaging and artworks for a Brighton & Hove Bus, to communicate issues around HIV, its treatment and the stigma of living with it. During the development and consultation period I worked closely with members of the LGBTQ+ community, as well as those living with the virus. I have more recently worked with Alzheimers Research UK and Sussex University designing a new public health awareness campaign and bus livery. In 2019/20, I was artist in residence at HMP Swaleside, creatively working with inmates, all living with varying mental health issues or personality disorders.
